

October 2025 Prayer Guide

This guide is an opportunity for us to join together in prayer, believing what God's Word says about the power and necessity of prayer. The Lord has established that He acts in response to our prayers as we pray in accordance with His will. As we focus our prayers together in specific ways, we believe we will see God move in power within and around us.

The prayer points focus us toward areas which Scripture instructs us to pray: for our pastors and each other, for ministries, missionaries, and government leaders, for persecuted believers, the lost, and Christ's return. We are also to cry out to the Lord with personal concerns and for our own growth; the Scripture for "Salem & Self" contributes to this.

Prayer Matters!

From IMB missionary John Pratt: "I got to the field and realized my utter dependance on God and prayer! I found there is an *indescribable difference* in the effectiveness and outcomes of the work when you alone are praying versus when an entire group of people are praying all around the world. These prayer warriors are in different time zones, allowing their own convictions and faith to be tested as they pray for seemingly impossible tasks...

When I allowed God's people to pray for me, that was the moment my entire ministry in South Asia changed. As a result, we now read stories like Lahud's and so many others who are among the first of their people to proclaim Jesus' name... So, when you ask, "What does it mean to have people pray for you?", it means God STILL answers prayers."

Wednesday, October 1

- Pastor David: The Lord's presence Psalm 42:8
- Salem & Self: 1 Peter 3:8
- Pray for the upcoming trip to the Dominican Republic, that God will bring together each detail in His sovereignty and foresight, and that He will prepare the way before them to grow His kingdom and accomplish every purpose.
- Pray that God would bring relief and provision to those in need in our community through the generosity of His people, and that through that provision they would see His goodness and open their hearts to the gospel of Christ.

One day each week will include a prayer focus that the people of our nation will return to the Lord and that He will bring renewal and salvation.

- · Salem & Self: 1 Peter 3:15

- Matt and Anabella Parker, supported missionaries in Ecuador: Praise God that He continues to use the Players of Hope (mp3 players with Bible teaching) to impact lives along the river the Parkers have heard several testimonies of people who have opened their hearts to Christ! Continue to pray for their FM Repeater Applications. The government has canceled the current process, requiring them to reapply for new stations in Baños, Lago Agrio, and Ibarra. These cities currently lack a local Christian radio presence. Lago Agrio, in particular, is a strategic location. Pray that Christian radio can be a powerful light in this region.
 - Samaritan's Purse continues to comfort and support those affected by the tragic flooding in the Texas Hill Country. Pray for the teams as they help with cleanup and rebuilding and share the gospel. As of last month, 140 people had accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior! Pray for God's work in this community to comfort, heal, and save.

- Pastor David: Holy Pursuit 1 Timothy 6:11
- Salem & Self: 1 John 4:4
- · Pray that through this month our focus will be on Christ and His goodness, authority, and truth, not drawn into the world's corruption and the darkness that can be prevalent. Pray that we will rejoice in our Lord's power and light.
- Persecuted believers in the Democratic Republic of the Congo: Over the course of two days last month, more than 100 Christians were killed by militants and many were kidnapped. Christians in sub-Saharan Africa are some of the world's most resilient believers and the gospel is spreading, but the incessant killings are taking their toll. "The massacres are weakening the faith of Christians...Please, brothers and sisters, let us unite in prayer to counter the enemy. God says if He does not watch over the house, those who watch, watch in vain." "Pray for God's comfort, His provision to the displaced, and for His Spirit to give them strength to stand firm amidst these targeted attacks."


- Pastor David: Confidence in God's Word Isaiah 55:11

Gospel Peace Church is in a region of Utah with 150,000 people, where most are Mormon and less than 1% are evangelical Christians. It is also the home of Utah State University. Pray also for this church, currently meeting in a community center, to find a permanent home.

- · Pray for Gideons International, that God will abundantly provide the finances for their outreach and that He will continue to bring salvation to many through this ministry.

- Persecuted believers in Turkmenistan: The government closely monitors Christians, especially Christian leaders. Printing or importing Christian materials, holding meetings, or downloading Christian songs can result in a fine, or worse. Muslim family and community members pressure and threaten believers. Pray for government leaders to have their hearts softened and find the hope of Jesus. Ask God to make a way for His Word to reach believers hungry for Scripture. "I cannot live without Jesus. I cannot deny Him, even if it means being persecuted. God gives me the comfort and desire to pray even more for my relatives and community who do not yet know Jesus."

When someone responds, the team begins a conversation, whether introducing the gospel or for discipleship. They ask for prayer for their latest strategy to create effective content for women, and for people with digital skills to join their team.

- Pastor David: To not be anxious Matthew 6:31-33
- · Salem & Self: Romans 12:11
- Pray for the youth in our student ministry, that the Holy Spirit will strengthen them in the Lord to believe and stand confidently in His truth, and that they would walk in the freedom and power of Christ.

Know that your personal requests are also important to God, because you are important to Him.

- Pray for those involved in or dabbling in occult practices, that the Holy Spirit would shine into their hearts the light of the gospel of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ and remove the deception of the spiritual enemy, that the veil would be removed from their minds and they would see light and choose salvation (2 Corinthians 4:3-6).

- NC Baptists prayer focus for October: Immigration into the United States has opened up new opportunities for the
 gospel to flourish and churches to be planted among American people groups. Pray for God to raise up believers
 from American people groups who can be trained to take the gospel to the unreached, unengaged peoples living
 all around them. Pray that NC Baptist churches would partner together to reach those from Central and South
 America, and that God would guide Salem with wisdom in how we can effectively engage people in our community.

- Paul and Sonya Gale, supported missionaries in Brazil: Pray for the leaders and students at the Brazilian Indian ministry as they study God's Word, that the Spirit would give them insight, wisdom, and clarity of thought in their studies. Pray that they would grow not only in knowledge but also in relationship with Christ. Pray that Paul and Sonya's work with this ministry will continue to grow and bear much fruit.
- Will Graham is preaching at an event in Tallinn, Estonia on October 18th and 19th. Estonia is one of the least religious countries in Europe, where the people live with fading hope and rising fear of the future. Pray that the Lord God will draw people from all walks of life to Himself through this event and strengthen local churches to disciple new believers and continue to spread the gospel.
- · Pray for the people of our nation to return to the Lord and that He will bring renewal and salvation.

Saturday, October 18

- Pastor David: Trust Psalm 62:8
- Salem & Self: 2 Corinthians 10:4-5
- Pray for the women's ministry, that the Lord continue to guide leadership in what He wants to do in and through the women at Salem, and that the Spirit will unite each together in love, encouragement, and service for Christ.
- Persecuted believers in Oman: While most Omanis practice a moderately conservative form of Islam, there is almost no tolerance for family members who convert to Christianity. Those who convert are put under pressure to recant and can be expelled from the family home, lose their jobs, and face problems over child custody and inheritance. Immigrant Christian communities are tolerated as long as they avoid sharing their faith with Muslims, but their facilities are restricted and meetings are monitored for political statements. Pray for God's protection and for His wisdom and boldness to believers to live out their faith and shine the light of Christ.

At 2 years old, he was showing developmental delays, and at 10 years old a professional assessment revealed how severely he was struggling. Through a ministry established for missionary children, Mila was able to get the resources and training to help him, and he is now attending college. She fought discouragement and spiritual attack, but God sustained her as well as her husband and their team in their mission work. Thank the Lord for His provision for all of their needs, and pray as they continue to serve in South Asia.

May the Holy Spirit pour out upon those who attend that "the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ" (2 Corinthians 4:6) may shine in them and lead them to repentance and faith.

- Pray for our member care team and care coordinators, for God's blessing and protection from spiritual attack.
- Persecuted believers in Ethiopia: Non-traditional Christians get the harshest treatment from local authorities and
 the Ethiopian Orthodox Church. In the east and southeast, converts from Islam and those from Orthodox
 backgrounds face intense family and community pressure. In other regions, Christians are attacked by Islamist
 mobs and often denied community resources, leading to social isolation. Political violence in the past 3 years has
 made things worse, with many churches destroyed. Pray for unity among Christians in Ethiopia, that God will
 connect them in community, and that He will give them strength to persevere and peace beyond understanding.

- Pray for sensitivity to the Spirit, that you may hear and obey God's voice more clearly.


